RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Refer to Static Exhibits General Rules.
- The garment must have been sewn during the current year between August 30, 2023, and August 29, 2024, and must be the work of and modeled by the person submitting the entry, except in the made for division. The garments will be judged on Friday morning and modeled at the State Fair Style Show which will be held at 3:30 PM Friday, August 30, 2024, in the Horizons Hall Auditorium.
- All exhibitors must have at least one garment modeled in the style show or they will not be eligible for prizes. <u>Exhibitor must indicate</u> which garment(s) will be modeled on the entry form. A narrative form must be filled out for each outfit modeled.
- Entries MUST be made in proper division according to age limits for each division or entry may be disqualified. (Note: Age limits are listed under each division.)
- Entrants may enter up to 3 classes in a division. Eligibility for a division is determined by the age limits and rules set forth in each division.
- Coordinator will email show and judging schedules to individual contestants. NO ENTRY TAGS ARE MAILED HOWEVER IN THIS DEPT.
- Judges will base the selection on material choice to pattern, overall workmanship, appearance, and suitability to the individual. Judging will be on the individual only; no hanger judging.
 Garments are to be brought the day of judging only, and each model/and or entrant is responsible for own garment. The models

may wear or carry appropriate accessories to complete an outfit.

- 8. Any Entry that is not complete when received by the SD State Fair office will be ineligible for competition in the style show.
- **9.** For the entry to be accepted by the State Fair it must be complete with the following:
 - A sample of fabric
 - The pattern, a picture, or drawing
 - A narrative form —a separate narrative form for each garment, with fabric sample attached, must be completed. A narrative form has been included in this book for your convenience.
- 10. Submit a picture of garment on the model, at the time of entry submission.
- 11. <u>A person can win the Sweepstakes Award in</u> only one division per year.
- 12. A Sweepstakes Winner may compete for ribbons and cash premiums the following year but will not be eligible to win the Sweepstakes Award two consecutive years in any division. Sweepstakes winners' entries will be on display fair week.
- 13. The judge" decision will be final.
- 14. All items must be sewn unless otherwise specified.
- 15. Age refers to actual age as of August 30, 2024.
- 16. On the day of the contest, all contestants must complete judging competition and style show. Any conflicts contestant may have with any other South Dakota State Fair competition is to be resolved by the contestant & superintendent.
- 17. If no entries are made in a division or class for three years, the division or class will be deleted.
