**South Dakota State Fair announces RED – A Taylor Swift Tribute**

HURON, S.D. –The South Dakota State Fair rounds out their Grandstand lineup with RED – A Taylor Swift Tribute on Monday, September 2 at 1 P.M.

“Red – A Taylor Swift Tribute” is a jaw dropping, faithful recreation of a live Taylor Swift concert. RED is fronted by Lauren Corzine, an amazingly talented and stunningly beautiful young vocalist and performer. Throughout her career as a singer/songwriter, Lauren was told that she looks and sounds just like Taylor Swift. Lauren decided to embrace her striking resemblance to the pop icon and founded RED. The result has been explosive. Taylor Swift fans flock to RED shows to see an authentic recreation of a live Taylor Swift show.
